

The National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame's annual Student Art Exhibition is back! *Win, Place, Show* will display student artwork in the Museum's von Stade Gallery in the spring of 2025. This year's exhibition is sponsored by the New York State Breeding and Development Fund.

Participating students and their families are welcome to visit the Museum for free to see their artwork on display during the show dates listed below. One piece of artwork from Grades 3-7 and one piece of artwork from Grades 8-12 will be selected as the "Best in Show" and will be featured on the Museum's website. The two winning students will each receive a slate of fabulous prizes. Additionally, the 8-12 winner will have the opportunity to present their art to the winner of the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame Stakes at the Saratoga Race Course in August.

Submission Rules:

- Artwork must be equine themed. The artist is free to interpret that as they wish. All mediums are accepted.
- If art is on paper, it must be matted. There are no size restrictions. All artwork will NOT be accepted.
- The entry form below must be attached to the back of each piece of artwork.
- Artists/teachers are responsible for picking up their art after the exhibition.
- The submission deadline is final; absolutely no submissions will be accepted after the deadline.

Art Drop Off Deadlines:

- Grades 3-7: February 23, 2025
- Grades 8-12: March 30, 2025
