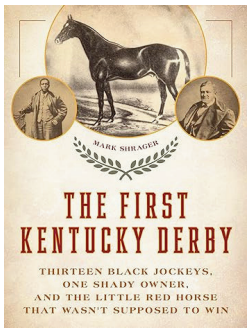


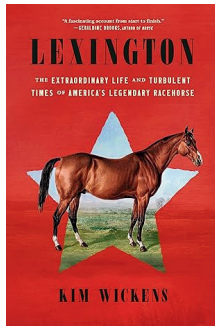

Throughout 2024, we'll be reading six incredible books that highlight a variety of perspectives on the world of horse racing:

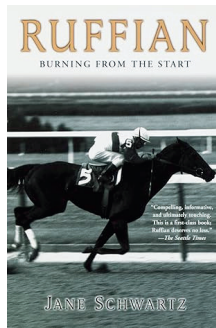
