HOW IT WORKS

Step 1: Teachers select one of the three books below based on grade level.

Step 2: The Museum will mail or drop off, depending on location, up to 30 copies of the book to your school for temporary use.

Step 3: After your class has read the book, the Museum Educator will visit the class, either in-person or virtually. This visit will include an interactive discussion and a presentation of artifacts from the Museum related to the book.

Step 4: The books return to the Museum, either picked up in-person or mailed back to us. It's that simple!


